



Referee Expectations

1. Attend the Referee Meeting on either December 7, 2024, from 9:00am to 10:30am or on December 14, 2024, from 12:30pm to 2:00pm at Chapelwood UMC, 11140 Greenbay St. Houston, Texas 77024.
2. Pick up assigned equipment at Chapelwood UMC on January 11, 2025 by 7:00am and return the assigned equipment to Chapelwood UMC on February 22, 2025 after the last game.
3. Notify the Chief Executive Officer at least 4 days in advance, or as soon as possible (for family emergencies) if you are unable to work as scheduled.
4. Arrive at the gym each week 30 minutes before the 1st game and work all games scheduled for that day.
5. Value and respect the facility you are working in and treat the facility as if you personally owned it.
6. The Head Referee will ensure that players, coaches, parents, and visitors always conduct themselves in a manner consistent with the mission statement of Texas Kingdom Basketball, as outlined in the Code of Conduct Statement that was agreed to during the player registration process.
7. Engage adult attendees to be an example and encourage all attendees to listen to the Devotional.
8. The Referee should set a Christian example. Communicate and engage those in attendance at the games. Become familiar with the attendees, seek ministry opportunities, and encourage church attendance.
9. Stay actively involved and unbiased at each game.
10. Do not use electronic devices during a game.
11. Recognize that pay rates for Referees will be prorated based on game schedules and gym hours. A full workday is considered to be 7:30am to 5:15pm.
