



First Baptist Academy's Warrior Field Usage Standards

The use of Warrior Field is a privilege. Please take a moment to review the following guidelines for its use.

TKSCA Parent/Spectator Addendum

EQUIPMENT

- No outside equipment or property may be left or stored overnight without prior permission.
- No speakers or equipment projecting music are allowed.

DECORATIONS

- No posters, handbills, pictures, etc., may be taped, tacked, nailed, glued, or stapled to any building surfaces, including walls, doors, ceilings, windows, fences, or bleachers.
- No tape, paint, or markings of any kind are allowed on the turf or track. Additionally, no carnival-type supplies such as confetti, silly string, shaving cream, whipped cream, eggs, or water balloons may be used on the field or track.

PARKING

- Guests may park inside the stadium gate and/or in the overflow lot (located across the street).
- Guests must enter the parking lot through the Long Point Rd. gate side and exit via the Silber Rd. gate side.

FOOD & DRINKS

- No food or drinks (other than water) may be taken onto the field or track by coaches and players. All food must be prepared off-site; however, food deliveries are acceptable.
- No tables, chairs, tents, etc., are to be placed on the track or the field inside the fence.

ETIQUETTE

- All events and participants should conduct themselves in a Christ-like manner.
- Alcohol, smoking, and drugs are strictly prohibited on FBA Athletic Complex property.
- No pets are allowed on FBA Athletic Complex property, including in cars, on leashes, or being held.
- No firearms or weapons are permitted on FBA Athletic Complex property.
- Coaches and athletes are the only ones allowed onto the track/field. Parents and spectators must remain behind the gates or in the stands.
