



REFEREE EXPECTATIONS

1. Pick up assigned equipment based on the schedule provided by director for each sports league.
2. Arrive at the location each week 30 minutes before the 1st game and work all games scheduled for that day.
3. Value and respect the facility you are working in and treat the facility as if you personally owned it.
4. The Head Referee will ensure that players, coaches, parents, and visitors always conduct themselves in a manner consistent with the mission statement of Texas Kingdom Sports, as outlined in the Code of Conduct Statement that was agreed to during the player registration process.
5. Engage adult attendees to be an example and encourage all attendees to listen to the Devotional.
6. The Referee should set a Christian example. Communicate and engage those in attendance at the games. Become familiar with the attendees, seek ministry opportunities, and encourage church attendance.
7. Stay actively involved and unbiased at each game.
8. Do not use electronic devices during a game.
9. Notify the Texas Kingdom Sports representative if you will be absent, except for family emergencies, by the Tuesday preceding a Saturday game.
10. Recognize that pay rates for Referees will be prorated based on game schedules hours. A full workday is 7:30am to 5:30pm.
